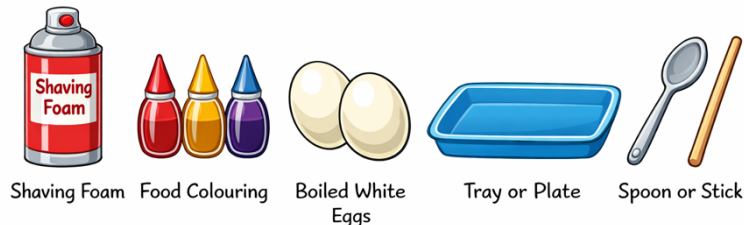

Shaving Foam Easter Eggs

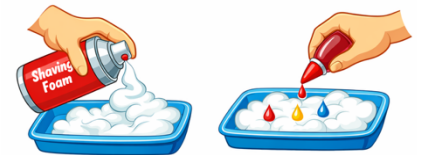
Colour Your Own Eggs

Materials:



Steps:

- Spray shaving foam onto a tray
- Add drops of food colouring
- Mix the colours gently
- Roll your egg in the foam
- Leave it for 5-10 minutes
- Wipe the egg clean gently



Did you know?

Decorating eggs is a very old tradition from many parts of the world.

People in places like ancient Persia decorated eggs for spring.

Later, this tradition became very popular in Eastern Europe.

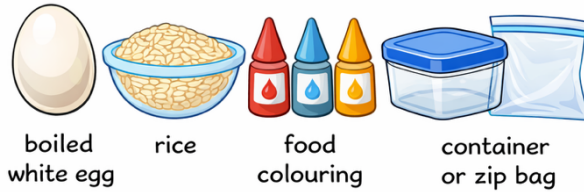
People used decorated eggs to celebrate new life and Easter.



Rice Shake Easter Eggs

Colour Your Own Eggs

Materials:



Steps:

- Put rice into a container or zip bag
- Add a few drops of colour
- Put the egg inside
- Close the container or zip the bag
- Shake, shake, shake!
- Take the egg out and let it dry

- Hold your egg in your hand

Easy Deviled Eggs

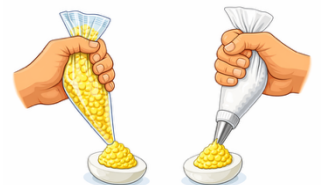
You can use your broken eggs to make a yummy Easter snack!

Materials:



Steps:

- Cut the eggs in half
- Take out the yellow part (yolk)
- Put it in a bowl
- Add mayonnaise and mix
- Put the mix into a zip bag
- Cut a small corner (ask an adult)
- Squeeze it back into the eggs

How to Use These Worksheets
